Full-time workload	 Exchange students usually take 3 to 6 courses per semester based on 3 credits per course. 3 credits course is consist of 48-hour workload. No minimum workload is required. Maximum workload allowed per semester is 19 credits (usually 6~7 courses) for undergraduates 12 credits for postgraduates 						
Information on courses open to exchange students	Consistent with its emphasis on global education, Ajou University offers a variety of courses taught in English. Currently, more than 300 students from various countries study at Ajou thorough our student exchange programs. Undergraduates can only choose undergraduate courses. In case students have enough knowledge to take postgraduate courses, they can take up to 6 credits from the postgraduate courses, but should go through prior approval of each professor. Postgraduates can choose both undergraduate and postgraduate courses up to 12 credits, but can take a maximum of 6 credits from undergraduate courses. Postgraduates applying for undergraduate courses need to check with the home university whether the credits can be transferred or not. * Exchange students enrolled in Master degree's program at their home university but not yet to obtain any Bachelor's degree should apply at an undergraduate student.

	• Exchange students must be a full-time student in one of Ajou's exchange partner universities and have completed at least 1 semester of study at home university.
	• Students from a non-partner university should have completed at least 1 semester of study at home university and meet the requirement of above 3.0/4.5 on GPA and the language proficiency.
Language requirement	English: TOEFL IBT 71, CET level 6, IELTS level 6 or equivalent
	• If students do not have an official English score, the recommendation letter by a faculty will be needed to prove the student's English proficiency enough to cope with the curriculum conducted in English.
	• In case exchange students will take the courses in Korea at Ajou, they should have above level 3 on TOPIK or equivalent.

Visa requirements	Students need to obtain the D-2 Visa with the admission and invitation letter which will be issued by Ajou.					
Alien Registration	All students who stay in Korea for more than 90 days must apply for the alien registration card within 90 days of entry. It usually takes 3-4 weeks for the card to be issued.					

	On-campus immigration service will be provided for one day in the beginning of the semester for all new foreign students.
Insurance requirements	We request Health Insurance for exchanges students during staying in Korea. Students can purchase health insurance from their home countries, or they can purchase it through the Office of International Affairs (OIA) at Ajou. Student should submit a copy of their insurance before or upon arrival.
Health Check-up	All students have been requested to submit the health and medical clearance form with their online applications as part of the required documents.
	According to government regulation, students from certain designated countries will need to get re-tested for tuberculosis at the district public health center in Korea upon arrival.
	The designated countries are: China, Sri Lanka, Russia, Uzbekistan, Thailand, Vietnam, India, Nepal, Indonesia, Pakistan, Mongolia, Bangladesh, the Philippines, Myanmar, Cambodia, East Timor, Kyrgyzstan and Malaysia,
Orientation	All international students are required to attend the orientation. During the orientation, important information such as academic schedule, alien registration, health insurance and tips for living in Korea will be introduced to prepare students for life in Korea. A campus tour and welcoming reception will follow the orientation.

Meals and Food	Students can buy various types of meals on and off-campus, and also cook some instant snacks in the shared kitchen of the dormitory. Students usually use the kitchen to cook noodles, toast, and small snacks or to keep their own food in the communal refrigerator. Normal meal prices range from 3,500 won to 5,000 won (approx. US\$ 3~5) per meal.
Opening a bank account	It's optional. If students would like to open a bank account in Korea, they will need to bring a home country ID card such as residential identification or driver's license and/or a passport and Ajou student ID card.
	ISEP students should open a bank account in Korea to receive the stipend.
Other important information	Every fall semester, there is Ajou International Day festival where students present their culture and food, and introduce their school to Ajou. It's a good idea for students to bring traditional displays and costumes to wear to the festival.
